Certificate of Origin

This certifies that all NEW wooden pallets supplied and manufactured by REMMEY "The Pallet Company", 3685 Sawmill Road, Beaver Springs, PA 17812 to "GAF, 2093 Old Route 15, New Columbia, PA 17856" were constructed using lumber harvested and sourced in North America.

If needed and applicable, REMMEY does Heat Treat (HT) certain specific pallets for GAF in accordance with the IPPC- ISPM 15 protocol for Solid Wood Packaging Material (SWPM). Those pallets have been certified and marked with the IPPC logo in accordance with the International standard. The Heat-Treating process is all natural, no chemicals are used by REMMEY in the manufacturing process for GAF. The Heat-Treated pallets have been Heat Treated to a minimum core temperature of 56°C/132°F for a minimum of 30 minutes. This Heat-Treating schedule meets the International Plant Protection Convention (IPPC) and Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) regulations adopted on March 15, 2002. All Heat Treated pallets have been marked with the licensed "IPPC" stamp (11450) bearing REMMEY's assigned mill designation, 2-letter ISO country code (US), inspection agency logo (PRL), the letters HT signifying the type of treatment and the licensed IPPC logo mark. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Animal Plant Health Inspection Services (APHIS) and the American Lumber Standards (ALSC) regulate & oversee the licensing and use of this stamp.

Pallets made by REMMEY for GAF New Columbia are 100% recyclable shipping platforms. REMMEY certifies that all lumber used in GAF New Columbia pallets is North American grown.

The pallets manufactured for GAF New Columbia conform to and meet American National Standard Institute (ANSI), MH1 – 2005, approved on 9 March 2005. This standard was developed by MH1 Committee for Pallets, SlipSheets and other Bases for Unit Loads and published by the Material Handling Industry, 8720 Red Oak Blvd., Suite 201, Charlotte, NC 28217.
